HOUSE AMENDMENT "J" to H. P. 1105, L. D. 1586, Bill, "An Act
Making Supplemental Appropriations for the Expenditures of
State Government and for Other Purposes for the Fiscal Years
Ending June 30, 1964 and June 30, 1965."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end the following section:
'Sec. 4. State Reserve Fund. There is established the State Reserve Fund to which there is appropriated, out of any moneys out of the General Fund not otherwise appropriated, the following amounts:

State Reserve Fund		
Unallocated	\$2,000,000	\$2,000,000

The above appropriated funds shall be available only for those purposes as may be determined by legislative action and shall not be used until the biennium beginning July 1, 1965, except that if the actual income of the State during the biennium ending June 30, 1965 is not sufficient to meet the expenditures authorized by the Legislature, the Governor and Council, before curtailing allotments so that expenditures will not exceed the anticipated income, shall use the above appropriated funds.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering the sections of said Bill to read consecutively.
