## STATE OF MAINE SENATE 101st LEGISLATURE

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1111, L. D. 1594, Bill, "An Act to to Authorize General Fund Bond Issue in Amount of Six Million Nine Hundred and Ninety-two Thousand Dollars and to Appropriate Moneys for Capital Improvements, Construction, Repairs, Equipment, Supplies and Furnishings for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 1964."

Amend said Bill in the Title by striking out the words "Six Million Nine Hundred and Ninety-two" and inserting in place thereof the words 'Seven Million Sixty-four'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out the figure "\$6,992,000" and inserting in place thereof the figure '\$7,064,000'

Further amend said Bill, in section 6, by inserting after the caption "FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION, DEPARTMENT OF" the following: 'FORESTRY, DEPARTMENT OF

Fire Control

Central Warehouse

72,000'

Further amend said Bill, in section 6, by striking out the line which reads "Total Allocations from General Fund Bond Issue \$6,992,000" and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Total Allocations from General Fund Bond Issue \$7,064,000'

Further amend said Bill, in section 6, by striking out in the next to the last paragraph the figure "\$6,992,000" and inserting in place thereof the figure '\$7,064,000'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph of the referendum, in section 8, and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:

' " Shall a bond issue be ratified for the purposes set forth in 'An Act to Authorize General Fund Bond Issue in Amount of Seven Million Sixty-four Thousand Dollars and to Appropriate Moneys for Capital Improvements, Construction, Repairs, Equipment, Supplies and Furnishings for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 1964,' passed by the 101st Legislature? " '
