HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 1116, L. D. 1599, Resolve, Proposing
an Amendment to the Constitution Affecting the Election,
Powers and Apportionment of the House of Representatives.

Amend said Resolve by striking out all of that part designated
"Section 2-A." and inserting in place thereof the following:

" 'Section 2-A. The first apportionment under Article IV,
Part First shall be made by the Legislature before the thirtieth
day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred
and sixty-four.' "

Further amend said Resolve by adding at the end, before the
"Form of question and date when amendments shall be voted upon"
the following:

"Constitution, Article X, Section 7, amended. Section 7 of
Article X of the Constitution is amended to read as follows:

'Section 7. ~~Sections~~ Section 2-A of Article IV, Part First, and
sections one, two and five, of Article X of the Constitution, shall
hereafter be omitted in any printed copies thereof prefixed to the
laws of the State, but this shall not impair the validity of acts
under those sections; and said section five shall remain in full
force, as part of the Constitution, according to the stipulations of
said section, with the same effect as if contained in said printed
copies.'"
