IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT to Appropriate Additional Moneys for Caribou Sewage Treatment Works.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the following legislation provides a supplemental state grant in aid for sewage treatment works construction to the Caribou Utilities District in the amount of \$53,560; and

Whereas, the construction, scheduled for completion early in 1964, cannot be completed without additional funds; and

Whereas, sewage treatment works construction is vital to the health and well-being of the people of Maine; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation for Water Improvement Commission. In order to provide for the necessary expenditures of government and for other purposes for the present fiscal year, from July 1, 1963 to June 30, 1964, the following sums or as much thereof as shall be found necessary, as designated in the following tabulation,

are appropriated out of any moneys in the General Fund not otherwise appropriated.
