STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FOUR

AN ACT Relating to Inhaling Certain Vapors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 137, § 17-A, additional. Chapter 137 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 17-A, to read as follows:

'Inhaling Certain Vapors.

Sec. 17-A. Inhaling certain vapors. Any persons willfully inhaling the vapors of glue, carbon tetrachloride, acetone, ethylene, dichloride, toluene, chloroform, exylene or any combination thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$50 or by imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or by both.'
