SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1157, L. D. 1628, Bill, "An Act Providing for an Additional Medical Examiner for York County."

Amend said Bill in the title by adding at the end before the period the following words: 'and Relating to the District Court for Southern York'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end the following sections:

"Sec. 2. R.S., c. 108-A, §3, sub-§XXXII, amended. The last sentence of subsection XXXII of section 3 of chapter 108-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 386 of the public laws of 1961, is amended to read as follows:

The District Court for Southern York shall be held at Kittery, Eliot or York, the exact site to be determined by the Chief Judge with the approval of the Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court.'

Sec. 3. R.S., c. 108-A, §4, sub-§X, amended. Subsection X of section 4 of chapter 108-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 386 of the public laws of 1961 and as amended by section 148-I of chapter 402 of the public laws of 1963, is further amended to read as follows:

'X. Tenth District. The 10th district consists of the divisions of Eastern York (Biddeford or Saco) ~~as-above-determined~~, the exact site to be determined by the Chief Judge with the approval of the Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court, Western York (Sanford) and Southern York (Kittery, Eliot or York), as above determined.' "
