HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H. P. 1166, L. D. 1675, Bill, "An Act Revising the Maine Employment Security Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after "Sec. 7", a new section 7-A, to read as follows:

"Sec. 7-A. R. S., c. 29, §14, sub-§V, amended. Subsection
V of section 14 of chapter 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended
by adding at the end the following sentence:

'Provided a claimant shall not be entitled to benefits
in his benefit year subsequent to his previous benefit
year unless he shall have earned 8 times his weekly benefit
amount subsequent to the beginning of his preceding benefit
year.'
