HOUSE AMENDMENT "I" to H. P. 1167, L. D. 1676, Bill,
"An Act to Apportion One Hundred and Fifty-one Representatives
Among the Several Counties, Cities, Towns, Plantations and
Classes in the State of Maine."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out all of
the 4th paragraph, which relates to Cumberland County, and
inserting in place thereof the following:

'The County of Cumberland shall choose 28 Representatives
to be apportioned as follows: Portland, 11 Representatives;
South Portland, 3 Representatives; Westbrook, 2 Representatives;
Brunswick, 2 Representatives; Scarborough, one Representative;
Falmouth, one Representative; Cape Elizabeth, one Representa-
tive; Gorham, one Representative; Cumberland and Harpswell,
one Representative; North Yarmouth and Yarmouth, one
Representative; Freeport and Pownal, one Representative;
Baldwin, Bridgton, Harrison, Naples and Sebago, one
Representative; Casco, Gray, New Gloucester, Otisfield and
Raymond, one Representative; Standish and Windham, one
Representative.'
