HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 1174, L. D. 1690, Resolve,
Authorizing the Attorney General to Convey Certain Land in
Raymond to the Town of Raymond.

Amend said Resolve by striking out all of the first
paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'That the Attorney General be authorized and directed
to convey by quitclaim deed to the Town of Raymond the interest
of the State of Maine for the sum of \$2,837.60 in a certain
lot or parcel of land, with buildings thereon, in Raymond,
County of Cumberland, and State of Maine, described as follows:'

Further amend said Resolve by striking out all of the
last paragraph, before the Statement of Facts, and inserting
in place thereof the following:

'Decree of Kennebec Superior Court recorded in Book 2827,
page 147, Cumberland Registry of Deeds.'
