RESOLVE Authorizing the Attorney General to Convey Certain Land in Raymond to the Town of Raymond.

Attorney General Authorized. Resolved: That the Attorney General be authorized and directed to convey by quitclaim deed land and buildings to the Town of Raymond by sale the interest of the State of Maine for the sum of \$2,837.60 a certain lot or parcel of land in Raymond, County of Cumberland, and State of Maine, described as follows:

Land and buildings situated in Raymond, Maine, and described in deed from Bernard A. Bove to Vincent Clark, dated April 24, 1939, and recorded in Cumberland County Registry of Deeds, Book 1578, page 101; excepting therefrom that parcel conveyed by Vincent Clark to Waldo Beck on August 8, 1960, and recorded in Cumberland County Registry of Deeds, Book 2557, page 167, and that parcel conveyed by Vincent Clark to Robert C. MacAusland on June 16, 1961, and recorded in said Cumberland Registry of Deeds, Book 2611, page 154.

Statement of Facts

The land and buildings above described escheated to the State of Maine on June 2, 1964 by decree of the Justice of the Kennebec County Superior Court by information filed by the Attorney General dated January 9, 1964, by reason of the decease of Vincent Clark, late of Raymond, same decree being recorded in Book 2827, page 147, Cumberland County, Maine, Registry of Deeds, June 3, 1964, and at the regular town meeting in March 1964 the Town of Raymond voted to buy the land and buildings for \$2,837.60 for the purpose of building a fire station on said land located in the village of Raymond.
