STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Educational Assistance for Orphans of Veterans.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 3211, amended. The last sentence of section 3211 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

‘War orphans, whose fathers entered the service from Maine or who have resided in the State for 5 years immediately preceding application for aid under this chapter and which children have graduated from high school and are not over 21 years of age at the time of first entering a vocational school or an educational institution of collegiate grade, shall be eligible for benefits provided under this chapter; **except that a war orphan who has been unable to enter before the age of 21 because engaged in service in the Armed Forces of the United States may enter when not over 25 years of age.**’
