AN ACT to Provide Funds for Expansion of Vending Stand Program for the Blind.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Vending stand program for the blind. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Welfare (Division of Eye Care and Special Services) the sum of \$5,797 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 and \$6,031 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967 for expansion of the Vending Stand Program for the Blind. The breakdown shall be as follows:
