### AN ACT to Provide Funds for Expansion of Home Teaching Programs for the Blind.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Expansion of home teaching programs for the blind.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Welfare (Division of Eye Care and Special Services) the sum of \$13,889 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 and \$14,490 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967 for additional home teaching positions for the blind. The breakdown shall be as follows:
