#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEXTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT Relating to State Retirement Benefits for Certain Teachers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., T. 5, § 1121, sub-§ 5, amended. The first sentence of subsection 5 of section 1121 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- 'Any teacher who began to teach in the public schools of Maine prior to July 1, 1947 and has attained 60 years of age shall, upon proper application and verification of at least 15 years of such teaching service, be granted a minimum monthly benefit of \$25 \$35.'
- Sec. 2. Effective date. Said minimum amount provided by this Act shall become effective on the first day of the month following the effective date of this Act and proper adjustments in benefits already being paid under the Revised Statutes, Title 5, section II2I, subsection 5, shall be made to those persons affected on the first monthly pension paid subsequent to said effective date.
