AN ACT Appropriating Moneys for Dredging Project at New Harbor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Dredging project at New Harbor; appropriation. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Town of Bristol the sum of \$4,000, to aid said town for a dredging project at New Harbor. Such appropriation shall not be available until a like amount has been appropriated by the Town of Bristol for the same purpose.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

A navigation project for New Harbor, Bristol, has been approved by the Chief of Engineers of the U. S. Army Engineer Division, New England, for accomplishment under authority of section 107 of the 1960 River and Harbor Act. The project provides for 1.4 acres of anchorage area, 6 feet deep, in New Harbor, in addition to that presently provided under the existing authorized federal project; and 2.2 acres of anchorage area, 6 feet deep, in Back Cove.

This project is estimated to cost \$125,000 of which a cash contribution of 6%, which is presently estimated to be \$8,000, is to be made by the local interests. The State of Maine and the Town of Bristol have given satisfactory indications that requirements of local cooperation will be met.

Initial funds have been allocated to proceed with preconstruction planning. In a short time local interests will be requested to furnish formal assurance that the requirements of local cooperation will be met.
