## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT Increasing Salary of Commissioner of Labor and Industry.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 26, § 41, amended. The 5th sentence of section 41 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The commissioner shall receive an annual salary of \$9,000 \$10,000, and in addition \$7,000 \$2,000 annually for his services as a member of the Industrial Accident Commission and his actual, necessary cash expenses while away from his office on official business of the Industrial Accident Commission.'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$1,600 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 and the sum of \$2,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967 to carry out the purposes of this Act.
