STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Conferring Degrees by Husson College.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Degrees. In addition to the rights and privileges and powers granted to Husson College by chapter 11 of the private and special laws of 1953, as amended by chapter 15 of the private and special laws of 1963, Husson College, a non-profit corporation, of Bangor, Maine, is authorized, by appropriate action of its trustees, to confer upon all who successfully complete a 2-year course of instruction in the field of Business Science, an Associate Degree in Business Science.
