AN ACT Creating an Official State Anthem.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 1, § 212, additional. Title 1 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 212 to read as follows:

'Sec. 212. State anthem. The official anthem of the State shall be the anthem entitled "I Guide or I Lead," words and music by Arthur Flag Roundy and Reverend Herbert Lester Reid.'
