STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Members of Industrial Accident Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 39, § 91, amended. The first sentence of the 3rd paragraph of section 91 of Title 39 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The chairman (of the Industrial Accident Commission) shall receive a salary of $\frac{1}{50,000}$ per year, and the other commissioners a salary of $\frac{9,000}{10,500}$ each per year.'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$4,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 and the sum of \$4,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967 to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Sec. 3. Effective date. It is the intention of the Legislature that this Act shall be retroactive to July 1, 1965.
