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### **AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Members of Industrial Accident Commission.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. R. S., T. 39, § 91, amended.** The first sentence of the 3rd paragraph of section 91 of Title 39 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The chairman (of the Industrial Accident Commission) shall receive a salary of ~~\$10,000~~ \$11,500 per year, and the other commissioners a salary of ~~\$9,000~~ \$10,500 each per year.'

**Sec. 2. Appropriation.** There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$4,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 and the sum of \$4,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967 to carry out the purposes of this Act.

**Sec. 3. Effective date.** It is the intention of the Legislature that this Act shall be retroactive to July 1, 1965.
