AN ACT to Repeal the Sweet Corn Tax and Laws Relating to European Corn Borer.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 7, c. 407, repealed. Chapter 407 of Title 7 of the Revised Statutes, relating to European corn borer, is repealed.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 36, c. 717, repealed. Chapter 717 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes, relating to the sweet corn tax, is repealed.
