COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 26, L.D. 38, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Length of Time for Controlled Atmosphere
Storage of Apples."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 12th, 13th, and
14th lines the underlined words "such minimum of 90 days may be
reduced to 60 days by the commissioner after public hearing" and
inserting in place thereof the following underlined words and
punctuation 'the commissioner, after notice and public hearing,
may change the minimum of 90 days to any number of less days,
as conditions in the apple industry may require'
