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**AN ACT Relating to Application for Milk Dealers to Sell Milk.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**R. S., T. 7, § 2902, amended.** Section 2902 of Title 7 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding after the 2nd paragraph a new paragraph to read as follows :

‘Every milk dealer, on his application for a license to sell milk, shall state where and when the milk he proposes to sell has been produced. He shall, after the license has been issued, conspicuously display such source at his place of business, buildings from which the milk is sold or distributed or the vehicles from which sales of the milk are made. This paragraph shall be enforced by the Division of Dairy Inspection, Department of Agriculture under such conditions as set forth by the Commissioner of Agriculture. The penalty for refusing to advertise or for making false statements shall mean the loss of license until such time as the conditions of this paragraph have been met.’
