AN ACT Appropriating Moneys for Sprinkler System at State Military and Naval Children's Home.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the following legislation is vitally necessary in order to protect the lives of the children at the State Military and Naval Children's Home; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sprinkler system at State Military and Naval Children's Home. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Department of Mental Health and Corrections the sum of \$19,600 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 for a sprinkler system and replacing defective wiring at the State Military and Naval Children's Home. Any unexpended balance shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until June 30, 1967.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.
