SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 39, L. D. 51, Resolve, in Favor of
Francis J. Boudreau, Jr., of Carmel for Damage by Highway
Construction.

Amend said Resolve by inserting at the end, before the period,
in the Title, the following: 'and to Reimburse Delmont R. Hawkes,
of Standish, for Well Damage'

Further amend said Resolve by striking out the period at the
end of the first paragraph and inserting in place thereof the
following: '; and be it further

Delmont R. Hawkes; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is
appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$500 to be
paid to Delmont R. Hawkes, of Standish, for damage to his well
caused by highway construction on Route 114.'
