RESOLVE, in Favor of Francis J. Boudreau, Jr., of Carmel for Damage by Highway Construction.

Francis J. Boudreau, Jr.; compensated. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$1,500 to compensate Francis J. Boudreau, Jr., of Carmel for damages to his well, plumbing, fixtures and health by the addition of harmful salt content.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Damage has been done to the well, plumbing, fixtures and health of Francis J. Boudreau, Jr. since 1955 due to the changes in the nature of the water in the Boudreau well, there being an excessive pollution or chloride content due to the drainage and penetration of the well and water by salt owned and used by the State Highway Department in connection with public highway #2, Carmel, near the Boudreau land and well.
