Daisy A. Reed; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$500 to be paid to Daisy A. Reed to reimburse her for expenses paid for an injury sustained at the State Armory in Millinocket.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

While attending a Kiwanis Club charity auction held in the State Armory in Millinocket, Mrs. Reed fell on a wet floor and broke her shoulder. The date of the injury was August 24, 1963. Mrs. Reed has receipted bills for nursing services \$300 and housework \$200.
