STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Mahlon Dore of York for Well Damage by Highway Construction.

Mahlon Dore; compensated. Resolved: That there be appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$1,500 to be paid to Mahlon Dore of York, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for damage, not compensated by the State Highway Commission, to his domestic water supply caused by the maintenance by the State Highway Commission of an exposed, reserve salt pile at a spot where the percolation of the salt through the subsoil has polluted said domestic water supply and by pollution from crankcase oils dumped on the same ground by Highway Commission maintenance crews.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The well owned by Mahlon Dore of York is located opposite the maintenance lot of the Highway Commission on Route I in York. The salt pile at this spot where the percolation of the salt through the subsoil has polluted the well water supply and also the pollution from crankcase oils dumped on said lot has polluted the well of Mahlon Dore and he is asking \$1,500 as a claim for damage to his well.
