STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Clarence P. Christenson of Gardiner for Loss of Poultry.

Clarence P. Christenson; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$70.20 to reimburse Clarence P. Christenson of Gardiner as a full and final settlement against the State for loss of poultry killed by dogs.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In June, 1964, 54 hens belonging to Clarence P. Christenson of Gardiner were killed by dogs. The owners of the dogs are unknown. The sum of \$70.20 is to reimburse him as a full and final settlement against the State for the loss.
