AN ACT Relating to Transportation for Pupils to and from Schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 220, amended. Section 220 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended by inserting after the 2nd sentence a new sentence to read as follows:

‘Conveyance so provided shall be so arranged that no pupil attending school below grade 7 shall be picked up earlier than one hour before the beginning of the school day and shall be returned to the point where such pupil was received no later than one hour after the end of the school day.’
