COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 46, L.D. 58, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Attending Secondary School Outside of
Residence."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
amending clause and inserting in place thereof the following:
"Any youth whose parent or guardian maintains a home for his
family in an administrative unit that maintains, or contracts
for school privileges in, an approved secondary school in
which the average daily membership, as reported in the pre-
ceding year, is less than 100 students and who has met the
qualifications for admission to the high school in his town,
may elect to attend some other approved secondary school in
the State to which he may gain admission for the purpose of
studying or of completing a sequence of courses in mathematics,
science, a foreign language or the social studies not offered
or contracted for by the administrative unit of his legal
residence. Except in case of change in the legal residence of
the student to a different administrative unit, transfer from
one secondary school to another may be made only at the
beginning of the school year."
