STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Attending Secondary School Outside of Residence.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 1291, amended. Section 1291 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end of the first paragraph the following:

‘Any youth whose parent or guardian maintains a home for his family in an administrative unit that maintains, or contracts for school privileges in, an approved secondary school in which the average daily membership, as reported in the preceding year, is less than 100 students and who has met the qualifications for admission to the high school in his town, may elect to attend some other approved secondary school to which he may gain admission for the purpose of studying any course or courses not offered or contracted for by the administrative unit of his legal residence or taught by noncertified teachers in the high school in his town.’
