AN ACT Governing Schools of Barbering in State Juvenile Institutions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 32, § 352, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 352 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end, a new sentence, as follows:

'Rules and regulations, promulgated under this paragraph, relating to size, numbers of chairs and students, shall not apply to any state juvenile institution conducting rehabilitation courses for its inmates.'
