AN ACT Relating to Qualified Assistant Pharmacists.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 32, § 2902, amended. The last paragraph of section 2902 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

‘Every person holding a valid and unexpired certificate of registration as a registered assistant pharmacist, in the State of Maine, on July 1, 1960, shall be registered as a pharmacist, prior to July 1, 1966, provided such a registered assistant pharmacist is of good moral character, has held such a certificate a minimum of 5 years, without formal complaint registered with the Board of Commissioners of the Profession of Pharmacy, and shall have been in actual practice as a registered assistant and actively engaged in retail or hospital practice of pharmacy for a minimum of at least 5 years immediately preceding the date of his request to be registered as a pharmacist. No examination shall be required of a person meeting the requirements of this paragraph.’
