STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Expenditures Under Town Road Improvement Fund Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 23, § 1705, amended. Section 1705 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 1705. Expenditures. The expenditures of this fund shall not exceed the sum of 60,000 \$9,000 in any one mile; except in unusual circumstances higher expenditures may be approved by the commission (Highway) at its discretion. The various towns shall assume and pay any cost or damages arising from any change in location, grade or drainage.'
