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**AN ACT Relating to Expenditures Under Town Road Improvement Fund Law.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 23, § 1705, amended.** Section 1705 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

**'Sec. 1705. Expenditures.** The expenditures of this fund shall not exceed the sum of ~~\$6,000~~ \$9,000 in any one mile; **except in unusual circumstances higher expenditures may be approved by the commission (Highway) at its discretion.** The various towns shall assume and pay any cost or damages arising from any change in location, grade or drainage.'
