SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 61, L. D.72, Bill, "An Act Providing for
Training in Safe Handling of Firearms by Certain Minors."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the 2nd underlined
paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

"The Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is
authorized to establish a program for training minors in the safe
handling of firearms and for this purpose may cooperate with any public
or private association or organization having as one of its objectives
the promotion of safety in firearms handling. The commissioner shall
prescribe the qualifications of instructors. The commissioner shall
prescribe the type and course of instruction and the time and place of
examinations for minors. He shall issue a certificate of competency
to such minors as successfully complete the examination."
