COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 68, L. D. 79, Bill,
"An Act Relating to Hospitalization for Mental Illness of
Convicts in County Jails."

Amend said Bill, in section 1, by adding at the end of
the 2nd underlined paragraph, the following underlined
sentences: 'He shall also have the rights as set forth in
Title 34, section 2376. If it is determined that he is not
mentally ill, and his sentence has not expired, he shall be
returned to the county jail.'
