IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Driver Education for Certain Motor Vehicle Operator Licensees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 29, § 2241-A, additional. Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2241-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 2241-A. Driver education for certain violators. Any licensee of the State of Maine who has had his license revoked or suspended and then restored, who has violated or fails to comply with any provision of this Title, or any rules and regulations established thereunder, shall be ordered before the Secretary of State for a hearing and show cause why he should not be ordered to enroll in a driver improvement course from a licensed approved school for 6 hours to study the laws, rules and regulations relating to motor vehicle operation. After he has attended such school, he must submit proof to the Secretary of State that such a course had been attended, by presenting a certificate from said school or a written letter from the instructor of said school stating that such a course was satisfactorily passed.

If the licensee does not within 6 months after hearing show such proof, his license shall be revoked or suspended for an indefinite period of time at the discretion of the Secretary of State.'

Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall become effective September 1, 1965.
