STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Providing Compensation for Members of Park Commission, School Committee and Police Commissioners of Town of Sanford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1935, c. 53, § 12, amended. The first sentence of section 12 of chapter 53 of the private and special laws of 1935 as amended by section 2 of chapter 28 of the private and special laws of 1949, is further amended to read as follows:

'Each member of the board of commissioners of police shall be compensated on the basis of \$100 \$200 per year.'

Sec. 2. Compensation of members of park commission. Each member of the park commission of the Town of Sanford shall be compensated on the basis of \$200 per year.

Sec. 3. Compensation of members of superintending school committee. Each member of the superintending school committee of the Town of Sanford shall be compensated on the basis of \$200 per year.
