AN ACT Revising the Beano or Bingo Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 17, § 303-A, additional. Title 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 303-A to read as follows:

'Sec. 303-A. Additional conditions. In addition to the rules and regulations promulgated under section 304, the license shall be issued under the following conditions:

1. **Limit.** All prizes, tokens or awards used, given, offered or awarded during, after or in connection with the conduct of any game or series of games conducted in any week may be paid in cash and shall not exceed the total amount of \$400.
2. **Door prizes.** Door prizes shall be legal.
3. **Type of play.** If announced at the start of every game, the 4 corners and diamond on the card may be played.'
