# STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT Relating to Obstructing Personnel of Fire Departments in Their Duties.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 17, § 2952, amended.** Section 2952 of Title 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end, a new paragraph, as follows:

'This section shall apply to all personnel of a fire department in the performance of their duties and said fire department personnel shall have the right to deny access to any area or building in which an emergency exists and for which the fire department has responded.'
