IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Snowplows on Railroads.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 35, § 1198, additional. Title 35 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 1198, to read as follows:

'Sec. 1198. Snowplows on railroads. It shall be unlawful for any railroad to operate, or any of its officers or agents to require or permit to have operated, a snowplow or other device used for plowing or removing snow, to be coupled ahead of a train or engine except or unless such train or engine is being operated for the exclusive purpose of plowing or removing snow.

Any railroad violating this section shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$200 and each violation shall constitute a separate offense.'
