IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Pensions for Certain Retired Teachers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 5, § 1121, sub-§ 2, ¶ D, sub-¶ (2), additional. Paragraph D of subsection 2 of section 1121 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subparagraph (2), as follows:

‘(2) \$480, if the member has at least 15 but less than 20 years of creditable service as a teacher.’

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Maine State Retirement System the sum of \$31,250 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 and the sum of \$37,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967 to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Sec. 3. Effective date. This Act shall become effective on September 1, 1965.
