HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 95, L. D. 104, Bill, "An Act Repealing the Law Regulating the Canning of Herring."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and inserting in place thereof the following new Title: 'An Act Relating to the Law Regulating the Canning of Herring.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

- "Sec. 1. R. S., T. 12, §3851, sub-§2, amended. Subsection 2 of section 3851 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- '2. Unlawful to can any herring during period. During that period it is unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to can in hermetically sealed containers herring of any description taken from the coastal waters of Maine.'
- Sec. 2. R. S., T. 12, §3851, sub-§4, additional. Section 3851 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 4 to read as follows:
- '4. Subsections suspended. The foregoing subsections shall be suspended if on November 1st of any year the commissioner shall determine that the total pack of herring in this State shall not have reached 1,250,000 cases and the suspension shall remain in effect until April 1st of the following year.'"
