STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Providing for Photographs of Persons Under Twenty-Five Years of Age on Motor Vehicle Operators' Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 540, amended. Section 540 cf Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:

'Each license shall bear thereon a photograph of the licensee, if under 25 years of age, which photograph shall be furnished by him.'
