COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 98, L. D. 107, Bill, "An Act to Create an Alternate Member to Serve on the State Probation and Parole Board."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the enacting clause, the following:

<u>'Emergency preamble.</u> Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the State Probation and Parole Board performs a most essential function of State Government; and

Whereas, the following legislation is vitally necessary for such functions to be carried out in an efficient and effective manner; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine, and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end, the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'
