IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Application of Federal Social Security to Firemen.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 5, § 1221, amended. The next to the last sentence of section 1221 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

‘This chapter shall not apply to teachers ~~and firemen~~ who are under a state or local government pension or retirement plan, except teachers at the Maine Maritime Academy.’
