

## STATE OF MAINE SENATE 102nd LEGISLATURE

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 66, L. D. 127, Bill, "An Act Relating to Penalties under Dealer of Livestock Law."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last 5 lines and inserting in place thereof the following: "1302 to 1307, or-neglect-or-refuse-to comply-with-any-of-theprovisions-thereof,-shall-be-punished-by-a-fine-of-not-more than \$200 for-the-first-offense-and-not-more-than \$500-for-each subsequent-offense shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500 or by imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or by both. or who shall violate any rule and regulation promulgated thereunder, or neglect or refuse to comply with any of the provisions thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$50.'"
