STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Permitting Merger of Maine General Hospital with Maine Medical Center.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Merger. Maine General Hospita, a corporation incorporated under the provisions of private and special laws of 1868, chapter 573, is authorized to merge with Maine Medical Center, a Maine corporation located at Portland in accordance with the vote of the corporators of Maine General Hospital at its annual meeting on November 18, 1964.
- Sec. 2. Powers and duties. Upon such merger, Maine General Hospital as merged into Maine Medical Center shall thenceforth be possessed of all the powers, privileges and immunities and subject to all the duties and obligations conferred by the corporation law of this State on corporations without capital stock, and all provisions of private and special laws relating to Maine General Hospital inconsistent therewith are repealed.
- Sec. 3. Repealer. Upon such merger, sections 3 and 5 of private and special laws of 1868, chapter 573, private and special laws of 1870, chapter 342, private and special laws of 1897, chapter 331, private and special laws of 1903, chapter 21 and public laws of 1921, chapter 94, are repealed.
